Record of Proceedings

The Petitioner’s representative submitted that the present Petition has been filed for the truing up of transmission tariff for the 2019-24 tariff block and the determination of transmission tariff for the 2024-29 tariff block for the Combined Assets under the “System Strengthening XIX Scheme” in the Southern Region.

2. After hearing the Petitioner’s representatives, the Commission directed the Petitioner to submit the following information on an affidavit, with a copy to the Respondents, within two weeks:

- a) Form-9C in Excel format.
- b) Single consolidated loan schedule for each source. Additionally, a summary determining the net loan schedule for each financial year (Form-9C).



3. The Commission further directed all the Respondents to file their respective replies to the Petition, if any, on an affidavit within two weeks, with a copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder within a week thereafter.

4. The matter will be listed for hearing on **16.9.2025**.
