Record of Proceedings

The Petitioner's representative submitted that the present Petition has been filed for the truing up of the transmission tariff for the 2019-24 tariff block and for the determination of the transmission tariff for the 2024-29 tariff block for the "315 MVA ICT-III at Nagarjunasagar Sub-station with associated bay equipment" in the Southern Region.

2. After hearing the Petitioner's representatives, the Commission directed the Petitioner to submit the following information on an affidavit, with an advance copy to the Respondents, within two weeks:



- a) Form-9C in Excel format.
- b) Single consolidated loan schedule for each source. Additionally, a summary determining the net loan schedule for each financial year (Form-9C).
- c) Reconciled Form-9C, due to de-capitalization.
- d) Reconcile the net loan, i.e., any adjustment of the loan due to de-capitalization (Form-6).
- e) Equipment-wise estimated cost against which the Additional Capital Expenditure has been claimed for the 2024-29 tariff period.
- 3. After the hearing, the Commission directed all the Respondents to file their respective replies to the Petition, if any, on an affidavit within two weeks, with a copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder within a week thereafter.
- 4. The matter will be listed for hearing on **16.9.2025**.
